TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL VIRTUAL AUDITION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Record as a MOV, MP4, M4V, WMV on your mobile device. Professional recordings are not recommended. Position the camera's field-of-view so that your upper torso is in clear view (i.e. no music stand blocking face). Ensure lighting and acoustics are adequate. 	
WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR A VIRTUAL AUDITION	Please record: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any example of your singing showing off the best quality of your tone and ability Optional to upload: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current performance resume 	Please record: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A 2-octave scale, on any syllable, without accompaniment An art song – <i>maximum length 5 minutes</i> A contrasting song of choice highlighting your skills (aria, jazz, folk song, show tune) – <i>maximum length 5 minutes</i> Please be prepared to upload: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current performance resume Current photo
