



Tips for a Successful Video Audition

Guidelines:

- Acceptable video formats are: MOV, MP4, M4V, WMV, or other similar easily accessible format. Professional recordings are not recommended.
- Position the camera's field-of-view so that your upper torso is in clear view (i.e. no music stand blocking face).
- Ensure **lighting** and **acoustics** are adequate.
- State your **name**, **voice type** you are auditioning for.
- Sing any **scale**, 1-2 octave range, without accompaniment.
- Sing an **art song**, live or pre-recorded accompaniment preferred.
- Sing a **contrasting song of choice**, highlighting your skills (aria, jazz, folk song, show tune)
- Entire audition should not exceed 10 minutes.

Video Audition Submission:

- 1) Follow the guidelines above to record your video.
- 2) Upload as a private video to a video site (Vimeo, YouTube, Google Drive, Google Photos, etc.). Your video will only be seen by the Audition Committee.
- 3) Ready to submit? Fill out the [Registration and Audition Form](#). Please be prepared to upload:
 - a. **Current resume**
 - b. **Current photo**
 - c. **Weblink to audition video or video file**
